

Friends of the Frauenthal Volunteer Program

A few facts about our volunteer program:

- We send out a calendar of events on a monthly basis to our members so they have an idea of what is coming up. Then, an email is sent out on the second Tuesday of each month that includes a link to sign up directly for upcoming events.
- The main volunteer responsibilities during a performance are ticket scanning, seating patrons (ushering), and bartending.
- Volunteers are asked to arrive 15 -30 minutes prior to the theater doors opening.
- When signing up for a performance, we ask that our volunteers stay for the entirety of the show.
- For those that would like to volunteer outside of performance nights, we also have monthly event poster distribution to local businesses as well as opportunities to serve as tour guides.

To become a volunteer, there are a few things to do first:

- We ask that you purchase a volunteer name badge from us for \$12. Please let us know if this cost is a financial burden and we can cover it through our Friends of the Frauenthal Tip Fund.
- Once you have purchased your name badge, we will start sending you training opportunities. After you have completed a training session, you will officially be an active volunteer.
- The volunteer uniform consists of a white button-down shirt or blouse, black slacks or skirt, a black jacket or blazer, and black closed-toe shoes.
